

Code of Conduct

for NAPROCK International Programming Contest

Purpose

This Code of Conduct applies to every individual participating in the NAPROCK International Programming Contest (participating students, faculty advisors, judges, representatives of sponsoring companies, organizing committee members, and other relevant parties; hereinafter referred to as “Participants”) that bear the responsibility to conduct themselves in a disciplined manner. This Code of Conduct establishes the basic standards of conduct that Participants and others must observe, with the aim of contributing to the development of the NAPROCK International Programming Contest.

Code of Conduct

1. Participants shall maintain a free mindset unbound by fixed gender roles and act with mutual respect and consideration.
2. Participants shall not engage in harassment based on gender, age, race, disability, country of origin, appearance or religion.
3. Participants must comply with laws and regulations
4. When using AI technology, participants must consider copyright, privacy, and ethical issues, and maintain fairness and transparency.
5. Participants must comply with the policies and guidelines established by the Organizing Committee of NAPROCK International Programming Contest.

The scope of this Code of Conduct extends not only to actions and speech during the final rounds of NAPROCK International Programming Contest (hereinafter referred to as “the Contest”), but also to all contexts related to the Contest (including posts on social media, team names, project titles, and text in application materials and all printed materials).
