# **Overview of the Competition**

## **NAPROCK** (Nourishment Association for Programming Contest KOSEN )

Established on July, 2008 under the industry-academia-government collaboration, we aim to respond in a socially open and global way to the increasing needs to enhance the development of high-level engineers that can correspond to the globalizing information industry. For 10 years, we have been hosting the "NAPROCK International Programming Contest" in Japan.

## **KOSEN Programming Contest (KOSEN ProCon)**

Competition for technical college students to examine the efforts of their daily studies and to compete their ideas and the abilities to realize them through information communication technology (ICT). 2019 saw the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the contest. The students compete their skills and ideas in 3 different divisions: Themed, Open and Competition.

## **NAPROCK International Programming Contests**

Hosted by NAPROCK, the international contests have been held jointly with KOSEN ProCon since 2009. Participants from Asian countries and from Japan have competed against each other. As per the request from many countries, we will be hosting the 11<sup>th</sup> Contest in Hanoi, Vietnam, the first contest to be held outside of Japan.

# **Contest Outline**

## Competition division: "Dance, Dance, Dance Around"

This is a territory game in which the teams compete to occupy as much territory as possible on a field divided up into grids. The students will become players and decide on the movements of agents on the game field. The points for each team are calculated from the squares occupied after a set number of turns are played and the team with greater total points wins the match. All teams compete in a single elimination tournament.

# Themed division: "Regional revitalization utilizing ICT"

Recently, social problems are expected to be solved by implementing innovations of the 4th industrial revolution (IoT, big data, AI, robot, sharing economy, etc.) into industries and social life. This can also be said about the regional issues. By solving these problems through ICT, we can enhance a more modernized society, safe living and communication among different regions. In the themed division, we seek entries of software developed from this kind of point of view.
